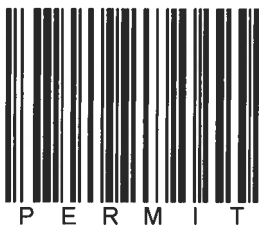

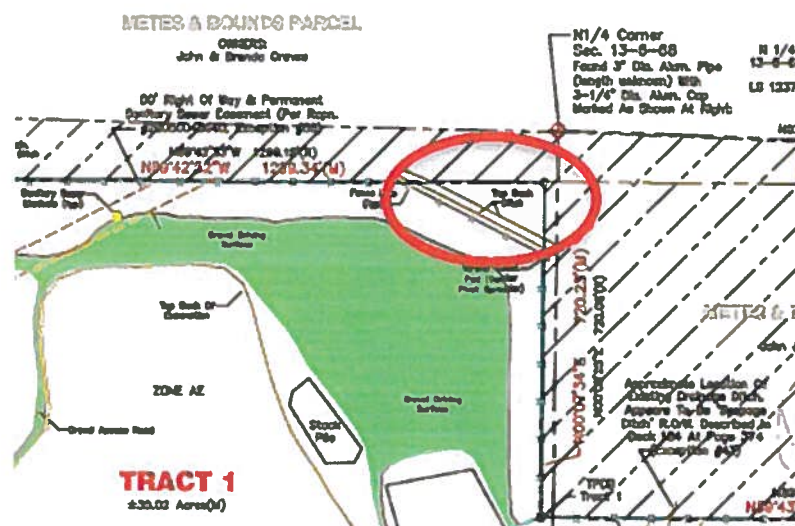

Re: Land Release adjustments following the site visit for Three Bells Mine, Permit No. M-1979-191

Dear Mr. Scott,

As discussed during the site visit on Tuesday October 21, 2014, Martin Marietta, Inc. (MM):

- has removed the Russian olive tree from the northeast corner of the southeast pond
- will relocate the stockpiles which were extending beyond the permit boundary

In addition to the above changes at the Three Bells mine property, figure 3 has also been modified to reflect:

- the well pad on the east side of the Veldman property has been added to the permit boundary figure
- the updated release area in the NE corner of the Veldman property to follow the fence line
- the figures have been cleaned up to remove info not pertinent to the M-1979-191 land release

The revised acreage for the land release includes an additional reduction of 0.55± acres from Tract 1, reflecting the newest permit boundary. As such, the acreage from Tract 1 will be reduced from 35.02± acres to 34.47± acres. The overall area to be released from the Three Bells mine is 47.80± acres. The acreage will not change for the other tracts on the Veldman property, nor the Ditullio property. Attached is the updated DRMS land release form in addition to figures 1 and 2, and an updated Figure 3.

As a follow up to your inspection last week for the release areas, please find attached photographs documenting that the stockpile extending slightly outside of the permit boundary has been moved back inside the permit boundary and out of the area we are requesting to be released.

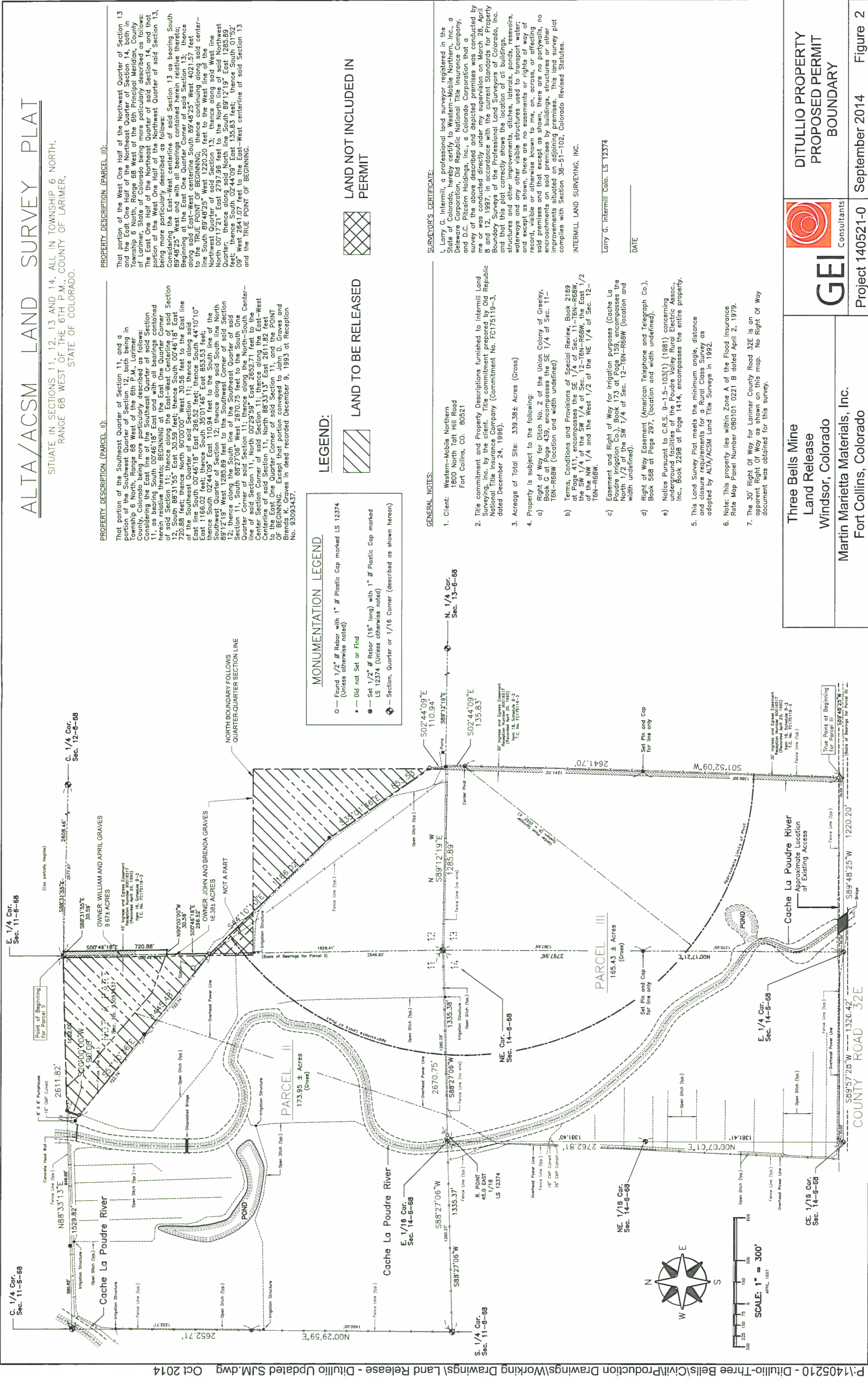
Also wanted to note, I discussed the issue with the plant personnel. When we laid out the new plant site and moved the plant from the south to the north, the stockpile in question was not anticipated. The stockpile was placed a couple of months ago at the request of the adjacent property owner (John Graves) to provide more of a noise buffer for his house to the east. He is also the owner of a portion of the properties we are asking to be released. The fencing was just completed two weeks ago to keep an adjacent owner's cattle out of the plant site. They had not yet had an opportunity to remove the pile once they discovered it was outside of our new requested boundary.
