On November 5, 2014, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety approved the succession of operators from Star Mine Operations, LLC to Fortune Revenue Silver Mines, Inc for this operation. Fortune Revenue Silver Mines, Inc is now the permitted operator of the Revenue Mine, and as such, is responsible for all provisions in M-2012-032, as well as those specified in the Rules and Regulations. Star Mine Operations, LLC is relieved of all responsibilities concerning this operation.
