

No new mining took place this year. Material was removed from stockpiles this year. When more material is needed, mining will resume in the stripped and partially mined area shown on the map.

A minor Technical Revision was approved this year to allow disturbance on the entire 9.99 acres and the Division reevaluated the bond and increased to \$22,000.00. The increase was filed on 8/21/2014

We estimate there is 53,000 cu-yds of topsoil/overburden is stockpiled on the mine at this time. No new exterior slopes were mine so no sloping is required. The maximum amount of disturbance allowed at the mine is 9.99 acres.

Approximately 0.16 acres or 160 linear feet of sloping is completed on the west side of the mine. No other reclamation is required at this time.
