NOTICE OF PROPOSED DECISION

The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety proposes to approve Technical Revision Application No. 83 (TR-83) for the Foidel Creek Mine (Permit No. C-1982-056), submitted by Twentymile Coal, LLC. Technical Revision No. 83 (TR-83) requests to modify Twentymile Coal LLC's approved mine plans to include initial development for the Wolf Creek Coal Seam Reserve. Initial development will include development and placement of long-term support for a 3-entry rock slope access, development of up to six sets of gate-roads and bleeder entries, and related ancillary activities including, underground dewatering activities and the extension of mine ventilation and support systems.

The Foidel Creek Mine is a/an underground coal mine located in Routt County, approximately 23 miles SW of Steamboat Springs, Colorado. Coal interest is federal, state and private, and the surface affected is federal, state and private land. The permit area encompasses approximately 20,100.00 acres.

This proposed decision is based on a finding that the proposed operation will comply with all requirements of the Colorado Surface Coal Mining Reclamation Act, Section 34-33-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S., and the regulations promulgated thereunder.

Copies of the proposed decision, including stipulations, are on file for public inspection at the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety, Room 215, Centennial Building, 1313 Sherman Street, Denver, Colorado 80203. Persons with an interest that may be adversely affected by the proposed decision may request a formal hearing before the Mined Land Reclamation Board on the proposed decision. Such request must be made within ten (10) days of the initial publication of this notice, must be in writing, and must state with reasonable specificity the reasons for the request and the objections to the proposed decision.
