Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the Bowie No. 2 Mine. The application was deemed complete on November 25, 2014.

Bowie Resources, LLC (BRL) is proposing to remove language from the approved permit application package authorizing the construction of three drill holes, eleven geotech holes, and the ground disturbance associated with those holes. BRL will not be drilling the holes or implementing the approved disturbance. BRL is proposing to reduce the reclamation liability by \$90,334.00; the area proposed to be disturbed would be reduced by 1.5 acres, and the proposed affected area reduced by 0.5 acres. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
