The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the West Elk Mine. The application was deemed complete on December 18, 2014.

The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted a Technical Revision to the West Elk Mine Permit. The revision proposes to update the locations of degas well pads and roads for longwall panel E6. The proposed changes would decrease the mine's disturbance acreage. There will be no changes to the mine's permitted or affected acreages. There will be a change to the mine's bond liability, which will be calculated during technical adequacy. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
