Mr. McGraw:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your response on December 19, 2014 regarding the problem identified in the inspection conducted at the Navajo Clay Pit on August 12, 2014. The status of the Corrective Action associated with this problem is as follows:

## <u>Corrective Action #1:</u> The Operator shall conduct a survey and replace the boundary markers in the correct locations around the area proposed to be disturbed for which a Financial Warranty has been posted. The Operator shall provide photo documentation to the Division that this has been done by the Corrective Action due date.

<u>Status:</u> The Operator submitted several photographs showing that boundary markers have been placed in their correct locations around the affected area. <u>Therefore, this problem is considered abated.</u>
