Dear Ms. Sauter:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the Bowie No. 1 Mine. The application was deemed complete on December 27, 2014.

With this revision, Bowie Resources, LLC seeks to update specific sections of the permit, related to the mine's train loadout facilities. The Loadout is located approximately one mile east of Paonia along State Hwy 133. Proposed modifications include: making an incidental revision to the permit boundary (increasing the permit area by 1.5 acres) to incorporate previous disturbance related to realignment of Black Bridge Road, a public road; updating information on property ownership and nearby structures; and providing additional details regarding drainage areas and culverts. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
