 Incidental Permit Boundary Revision**

Dear Mr. Boehms:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety hereby issues notice, in accordance with Title 34, Article 33, Section 118, Paragraph 3, of the Colorado Revised Statutes, that on December 27, 2014, an application to revise coal mining operations at the Bowie No. 1 Mine was considered complete for the purposes of filing. All review and comment periods as provided in the Act and the Regulations initiate from this date of filing.

With this revision, Bowie Resources, LLC seeks to update specific sections of the permit, related to the mine's train loadout facilities. The Loadout is located approximately one mile east of Paonia along State Hwy 133. Proposed modifications include: making an incidental revision to the permit boundary (increasing the permit area by 1.5 acres) to incorporate previous disturbance related to realignment of Black Bridge Road, a public road; updating information on property ownership and nearby structures; and providing additional details regarding drainage areas and culverts. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.

The underground coal mining operation is on land located approximately 3 miles North of Paonia. The permit area is further described as follows:
