On February 12, 2015 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) received correspondence regarding proposed changes to the water sampling and analysis plan for the Colony Oil Shale Project. The revised Sampling and Analysis Plan is due to a further reduction of activity at the site. The DRMS accepts the proposed reduction in water quality monitoring and revised frequency. Also, the DRMS will continue to require Exxon Mobil Corporation to report water quality data collected after each quarterly and annual sampling event.
