Please be advised that according to our records, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 2015 Annual Report and Map on February 9, 2015, but did not receive the Annual Fee, which is due February 24, 2015. Even though the due date is six days away and we're now aware that the 2015 annual report invoice, mailed January 2, 2015, did not contain the Annual Fee due on both the Annual Fee Invoice and Report Request and the attached 112c Annual Report form, the Division is offering a one-time 30 day grace period, effective February 18, 2015 for you to submit the following:

- 2015 Annual Fees (\$791.00) to: Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety – 1313 Sherman Street, Room 215 – Denver, CO 80203

This must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 20, 2015, or a Notice of Violation, Cease and Desist Order from <u>ALL</u> mining related activities, Civil Penalties equal to the amount to the annual fees due, and Notice of Formal Public Hearing before the Mined Land Reclamation Board for consideration of a <u>POSSIBLE PERMIT REVOCATION AND FINANCIAL WARRANTY FORFEITURE</u> will be issued for this account.

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## \*\*\*Please Note\*\*\* New Procedure - Effective July 1, 2014

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety will no longer send out second or final notices for past due Annual Fees. In accordance with the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Act for the Extraction of Construction Materials (C.R.S. 34-32.5-101), the office will send out a single notice for payment of Annual Fees and submittal of an Annual Report and Map. The report and fee are due on the anniversary date of the permit issuance. Where an operator is late in payment of the Annual Fee by more than sixty (60) days, the Division will automatically issue a violation and set the matter for a hearing before the Mined Land Reclamation Board for permit revocation and forfeiture. If a violation is issued, civil penalties equal to the amount of the annual fee will also be assessed.

For sites covered under the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Act (C.R.S. 34-32-101), the same procedure will apply, however, if payment is late by more than sixty (60) days, the operator will be issued a "Reason to Believe that a Violation Exists" letter, which will set the matter for a hearing before the Mined Land Reclamation Board for consideration of a possible violation.
