Dear Mr. Schuler:

On March 9, 2015, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your request to reduce the acreage at the Simla Highway Pit, Permit No. M-1995-095. We have determined that the following information must be submitted to complete the requirements stated in the second paragraph of the Request for Full or Partial Release of Permit Area form, and the requirements of Rule 4.17 of the Construction Material Rules and Regulations:

- You will also need to submit <u>updated mining</u> and <u>reclamation plan maps</u> that accurately <u>depict both the proposed acreage to be released</u> from the current permit area, and the resulting <u>new permit boundary</u>.
- 4.17.1(2) The Operator shall include in the notice to the Office the names and <u>addresses</u> and phone numbers of all owners of record to the affected land. *No addresses were included and the Division checked the El Paso County Assessors website which indicates land owners include: a) Vivian L. Shelton, and b) Morris D. and Verna D. Ververs.*
