This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety. The East Bradbury Pit is located 5 miles southeast of Whitewater, Colorado east of Highway 50. The site is a 112c operation. Gayle Lyman of Grand Junction Concrete Pipe and Supply Company accompanied the inspector during the inspection.

No mining related activity was observed at the site.

The currently held bond in the amount of \$107,139.00 is adequate.
