OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety. The Soaring Eagle Gravel Pit is located approximately 3 miles east of Fruita, Colorado off of Highway 340. The site is a 112c operation. Gayle Lyman of Grand Junction Pipe and Supply Company accompanied the inspector during the inspection.

The mine identification sign and boundary markers were in place and in compliance with rule 3.1.12. The sign is located on a post at the main entrance on the southwest side of the gravel mine.

The mine was active at the time of the inspection. Stockpiles of various sizes of sand and gravel were observed in Phase V. A loader was observed loading on-highway haul trucks with material.

No active excavation was observed during the inspection.

No problems or possible violations were observed during the inspection.

Photos that show the conditions observed during the inspection are included at the end of this report.

In an effort to ensure the financial warranty remains adequate to reclaim this site per the requirements of the approved reclamation plan, DRMS will update the reclamation cost estimate. The estimate will be forwarded to the operator under separate cover.


