The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) is withdrawing the Notice of Possible Violation sent on March 24, 2015 and removing the item form the April 29, 2015 Mined Land Reclamation Board (MLRB) agenda.

Please be advised that the Division will be re-issuing a notice of possible violation for the annual fees only and scheduling for the May 29, 2015 MLRB meeting. An audit by Division accounting and separately by Minerals Program administrative assistants does not support claims of payments made by Wildcat Mining Corporation. If Wildcat can produce verifiable documentation of payments the Division will reconsider or withdrawal the matter.
