Dear Mr. Coram,

The Division recently received the annual reports for the two permitted mines named above, and a small discrepancy in both of those reports was observed. It should be noted that your response to Item #3 of the reports, which asks if the mine site is in final reclamation, was "No" in both reports.

Please be reminded that both of these Hard Rock and Metals 110d permits are, in fact, in final reclamation. This is the stage that they were required to enter since neither of them could extend temporary cessation any longer and neither of them has an environmental protection plan.

As the annual report form states, Hard Rock and Metals Rule 3.1.3 places a five-year time limit on final reclamation. Please ensure that your reclamation schedule conforms to that time limit, and that future annual reports reflect the proper information regarding reclamation.
