On May 11, 2015 the Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) denied the succession of operators from Tiger Timber and Gravel, LLC for this operation due to failure to submit the required financial warranty.

As such, the Estate of Frank Laughrey is still the permitted operator of the Tiger Timber Site, and is responsible for all provisions in Permit No. M-1991-082, as well as those specified in the Rules and Regulations.

The Tiger Timber Site is under bonded at this time. As such, the Division will request the additional \$4,440.00 from the Estate of Frank Laughrey as the current Permittee and Operator.
