Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the West Elk Mine. The application was deemed complete on May 18, 2015.

The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted a Technical Revision to the West Elk Mine's Permit. The revision proposes new development mining in the currently leased B-Seam. The proposed longwall panel development is south of the old B-Seam panels and directly under the currently approved E-Seam panels. There are no proposed changes to the mine's permit area, affected area or disturbed area as a result of this revision. There will be no change in the mine's reclamation liability as a result of the changes proposed in this revision. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
