Dear Sir or Madam:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the Bowie No. 2 Mine. The application was deemed complete on May 29, 2015.

Technical Revision No. 103 (TR-103) proposes to temporarily suspend 23 hydrologic monitoring points that will not be affected by mining until 2018 or later. TR-103 also requests termination of 15 monitoring points that are no longer considered necessary or do not provide useful information. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.

Permit Revision (PR), Permit Renewal (RN), or Technical Revision (TR) application materials are available for review at the Paonia Public Library, 2 3rd Street, Paonia, CO 81428 and at the Division's Denver office.
