The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the West Elk Mine. The application was deemed complete on June 8, 2015.

The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted a Minor Revision to the West Elk Permit. The revision proposes to incorporate a new map into the permit showing as-built information for methane drainage well pads and roads for the E-Seam mining. There are no proposed changes to the mine's permit area, affected area or disturbed area as a result of this revision. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
