OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety. The Chambers Pit is located immediately west of Eagle, Colorado off of Fairgrounds Road. The site is a 112c operation that has almost been completely mined. Jason Burkey of Oldcastle SW Group, Inc. dba United Companies of Mesa County accompanied the inspector during the inspection.

The mine identification sign and the affected area boundary markers are in place and in compliance with rule 3.1.12.

The pit is currently being mined by Elam Construction who was observed operating an asphalt plant during the inspection.

According to the Operator the mine is nearing the end of the active mining phase and complete final reclamation will begin in the near future. Also Area F is no longer proposed to be mined and will remain as ball fields.

No off-site damage, problems or possible violations were observed during the inspection.

In an effort to ensure the financial warranty remains adequate to reclaim this site per the requirements of the approved reclamation plan, DRMS will update the reclamation cost estimate. The estimate will be forwarded to the operator under separate cover. The last bond calculation was done in 2010.




