Lincoln County would like to request reclamation release for the Fisher Pit. We had attempted this about 2 years ago, but had a few places that still had not been adequately revegetated. We feel that with the rains we've had, and the resulting growth, that we are now ready. Lincoln County still wishes to retain the access road to the Hoffman Pit, and will continue to pay the access fee agreed to between Lincoln County and Shriner's Hospital. Please see the enclosed request letter to ask for continuation for right to enter, and to retain the access road. Hopefully, you find our reclamation efforts adequate. Thank you.

ACCESS AGREEMENT

Re: Fisher Pit (M-1977-163-SG)

Access road (ranch road) located on property owned by the Owner located in the S/4 of the West ½ of Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 55 West of the 6th PM in Lincoln County, Colorado.

The right to enter will allow reasonable egress and ingress solely for access of Lincoln County personnel and their contractors (hereinafter referred to as "Permitted Users") to the Hoffman Pit, a gravel pit leased by Lincoln County, located on adjoining property in Section 10, Township 9 South. This access shall be granted to Lincoln County for the purpose of gravel removal activities, reclamation, and supervision and oversight of such activities.

Grantee agrees to pay a sum of \$400 (four hundred dollars) **yearly** due and payable the First day of July, beginning July 1, 2013 and ending July 1st of the year the Hoffman pit is fully reclaimed and released by the Colorado Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety, **and** the access road is fully restored to its original state.

Grantee shall indemnify, defend and save Owner harmless from any and all liability, loss, damage, cost, obligation and expense resulting from any injury to person or damage to property, or which arises out of or results from any negligent act, whether of commission or omission, of Grantee, their agents, employees, contractors, subcontractors, licensees or other invitees by, through or under Grantee, including the Permitted Users, occurring in, on or about the Owner Parcel whether in the exercise of Grantee's rights hereunder or in the breach or excess thereof.

Lincoln County is in the process of reclaiming the Fisher Gravel Pit so that we can gain a release by the State of Colorado. As you may be aware, the road going through the Fisher Pit is the only access the County has to another gravel pit (Hoffman Pit). For obvious reasons, we would like to maintain that access through the Fisher Pit. I have discussed this matter with Michael Cunningham of the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety. He stated that we can reclaim the pit, and maintain access if we file written approval from you giving us permission for this access. Please find the permission statement enclosed. If the terms are acceptable to you, please sign the lease agreement before a notary, and return the original to me at the above address. The \$400 / yr. fee Lincoln County pays to Shriner's Hospital for access through this pit will continue as long as that access is permitted.
