Bowie Resources, LLC has applied for a bond release at the Bowie No. 2 Mine. The bond release application was found complete by this Division on July 15, 2015. Bond Relese No. 1 requests the partial bond release for 33 acres of Phase I; 49.4 acres of Phase I and II; and 1 acres including 185 drilled holes and two sealed mine shafts for Phase I, II, and III. SL-1 requests the release of \$1,500,000 of liability associated with disturbances approved for the Bowie No. 2 Mine. The surface ownership is federal and private, and the coal mined was federal and private.

We will contact you to advise you of the Division's required bond release inspection of the site as soon as it has been scheduled. A proposed decision on the application will be issued within sixty (60) days of our inspection.
