The dashed line on Exhibit C-1 labeled as "Limit of Reclamation Liability" indicates the limits of the post-law disturbance. As successor to this permit, Continental Materials Corp (CMC) is responsible to reclaim the land inside the dashed line if the operation was to stop today (2015) or before substantial progress is made on the new mining plan.

As the new mining plan is implemented, the mining activity will re-disturb and mine through most of the present post-law disturbed area (land inside the dashed line). Also the new mining plan will disturb new lands, which are not now disturbed. Throughout the life of the mine, CMC will be liable to reclaim the land disturbed by the new operation (both inside and outside the dashed line) and land inside the dashed line but not re-disturbed by the new mining (such as the Fines Disposal Area and on top of bench 1).
