We have received your application for a minor revision to your permit to conduct coal mining in Colorado. Our initial review indicates that all preliminary items required by Rule 2.08.4(5) have not been submitted. Thus, your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing as of August 10, 2015.

In order to make your application complete, please submit the following information:

1.) The Division did not receive a cultural resources report for the proposed project area. Please submit this report. In order to better facilitate the State Historic Preservation Office review of the proposed project, the Division requests that in addition to a hard copy of the report that an electronic copy of the report be submitted as well.

2.) On August 6th, 2015 the Division received an e-mail from you regarding Twentymile Coal's consultation with Colorado Parks and Wildlife regarding this project. The e-mail included several attachments. No other wildlife consultation information was submitted with the application. Please indicate what documents Twentymile would like to include as part of Exhibit 23C.
