The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has received an application for the above referenced permitting action for the West Elk Mine. The application was deemed complete on August 10, 2015.

The Mountain Coal Company, LLC has submitted a Minor Revision to the West Elk Mine's permit. The revision proposes changes to several pages of text to update verb tenses and change the way coal reserves are presented, including updating the coal reserve numbers. These changes are administrative in nature. There are no proposed changes to the mine's permitted, affected or disturbed acreages in this revision. There will be no change to the mine's reclamation liability as a result of this revision. The applicant is not proposing additional surface disturbance outside of the area currently approved for disturbance.
