Homestake Mining Company of California (Homestake) hereby provides additional information regarding the management of drill cuttings per your communication dated July 3, 2015 regarding the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety Reclamation Pitch Reclamation Project Technical Revision #6 (TR6).

Drill cuttings resulting from the installation of two piezometers will be placed within the Tie Camp low grade ore stockpile (**Figure 1**). The installation of two piezometers and subsequent placement of drill cuttings (**Figure 2**) will result in an estimated disturbance of 0.4 acres as summarized in the TR6 application dated June 22, 2015 and approved June 25, 2015. Reclamation of the disturbed area within the low grade ore stockpile will be conducted during the 2015 field season.
