This letter, as required by Rule 3.02.2(5)(b) of the Rules and Regulations of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board for Coal Mining, is to inform you that the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety has issued a proposed decision to approve Permit Revision Application No. 7 for the Trapper Mine. This decision will be published in the *Craig Daily Press* as soon as possible. Publication of the notice initiates a thirty (30) day public comment period. If, within thirty days, there are no requests for an adjudicatory hearing, the decision will become final.

The revision application includes a proposal for reduction of the required surety in the amount of (\$4,014,314.80). The bond for the operation is a Corporate Surety issued by your company (Bond No. 64S100739153BCA), in the amount of \$30,173,724.00.

Please be aware that this notification is not a request to initiate any action by Travelers Casualty and Surety Co of America concerning Bond No. 64S100739153BCA, and is for your information only. Should Trapper Mining, Inc. chose to take action with regard to this bond release, they will contact you.
