The Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety (Division) inspected the above mentioned site on August 6, 2015. Sediment control was cited as problem. Corrective actions require the operator to submit photo documentation verifying ditch erosion has been repaired and that the site has been reconstructed and stabilized to prevent erosion damage. The corrective action due date was for September 30, 2015. On September 30, 2015 a formal request for a 30 day extension was received from Mike Gomez. The Division is approving the 30-day extension request.

To avoid potential future enforcement actions for non-compliance with State Statutes, Rules and Regulations, and/or conditions specified in your permit for this site, you must submit compliance documentation with the corrective actions specified by ***Friday, October 30, 2015***.
