Dear Mr. Eberl:

On October 1, 2015 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) approved the Technical Revision request (TR-2) submitted on September 25, 2015, addressing the following:

Revise the mine plan to reduce the maximum disturbance from 184 to 15 acres at any given time. The total affected acreage for life of mine will remain at 184 acres.

The terms of the TR-2 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1978-314. All other conditions and requirements of the permit remain in full force and effect.

At this time the Financial Warranty held by the Division will not be recalculated. Per discussions with the operator and the landowner a surety reduction request will be submitted upon approval of this technical revision. At that time staff will conduct a site inspection and recalculate the estimated liability based on current site conditions.
