On August 4, 2015 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) conducted an inspection of the above referenced site. Several issues were noted as problems with corrective actions and dates.

Problem 1 (one), identified in the inspection report, general compliance with mine plan for ceasing production of operations for one hundred eighty (180) days or more. Corrective actions required the operator to file for Temporary Cessation (TC). On October 9, 2015 the Division received a Temporary Cessation Notice from the operator. The TC notification requirements of Rule 1.13.5 and 6 will begin once the Financial Warranty increase SI-01 has been submitted and accepted by the Division.

Problem 2 (two), identified in the inspection report, revegetation for the presence of state-listed noxious weeds. Corrective actions required the operator to implement a weed control plan and the plan shall be submitted in the form of a Technical Revision to the Reclamation Plan. On October 9, 2015 the Division received a Technical Revision Request from the operator.

All problems identified in the August 4, 2015 inspection report have been abated.
