The proposed portable asphalt and concrete batch plants, installation of a commercial well on BLM, washing of material, and importing material will require a modification to the Mine Plan of Operations under 43 CFR 3809.431. An environmental review will determine if the proposed activities prevent undue or unnecessary degradation (UUD) under 43 CFR 3809 & 3715.
