

Water User Advisory Procedure

- Dial 303-679-2393 (County Dispatch)
- Identify yourself and tell the dispatcher you need to launch a Code Red Downstream Water User Advisory
- Read this language to the dispatcher, filling in specific information:

“This is a downstream water user advisory emergency notification, launched at the request of (*name and agency*). A possible contaminant (*specify if known and approx. quantity*) may have been released into Clear Creek at (*location, date and time*). This notice is provided so you can take whatever precautionary measures you deem appropriate. There is no further information at this time. Do not call Clear Creek dispatch for further information.”
