

\*\*\*INCIDENT OCCURS\*\*\*

RESPOND

In the event of ANY emergency involving **INJURY, FIRE, or PETROLEUM OR CHEMICAL SPILLS**, call the **BOILER OPERATOR** at **942-3501**.

If you do not have access to a telephone, state there is an emergency to Mill Control on any of the radio channels "**1 through 8**".

If you are unable to use the Henderson radio to report any emergency, you can use any regular mill phone. First dial "**9**" and then "**9-1-1**" to reach Grand County or Summit County Dispatch.

If the release involves a **HAZARDOUS MATERIAL**, remain a safe distance away from the material unless you are trained in hazardous materials response procedures.

If the release involves **HIGHLY TOXIC MATERIALS** or is a **LARGE VOLUME SPILL**, evacuate the area and call the **BOILER OPERATOR** at **942-3501** or Mill Control at **942-3532**.

If able to do so safely, **MITIGATE THE RELEASE**

- Attempt to extinguish incipient stage fires
- Shut off pumps, close valves, etc. if material is still being released. Shut off motors and electrical circuits.
- In case of injury, begin first aid up to the level of your training.

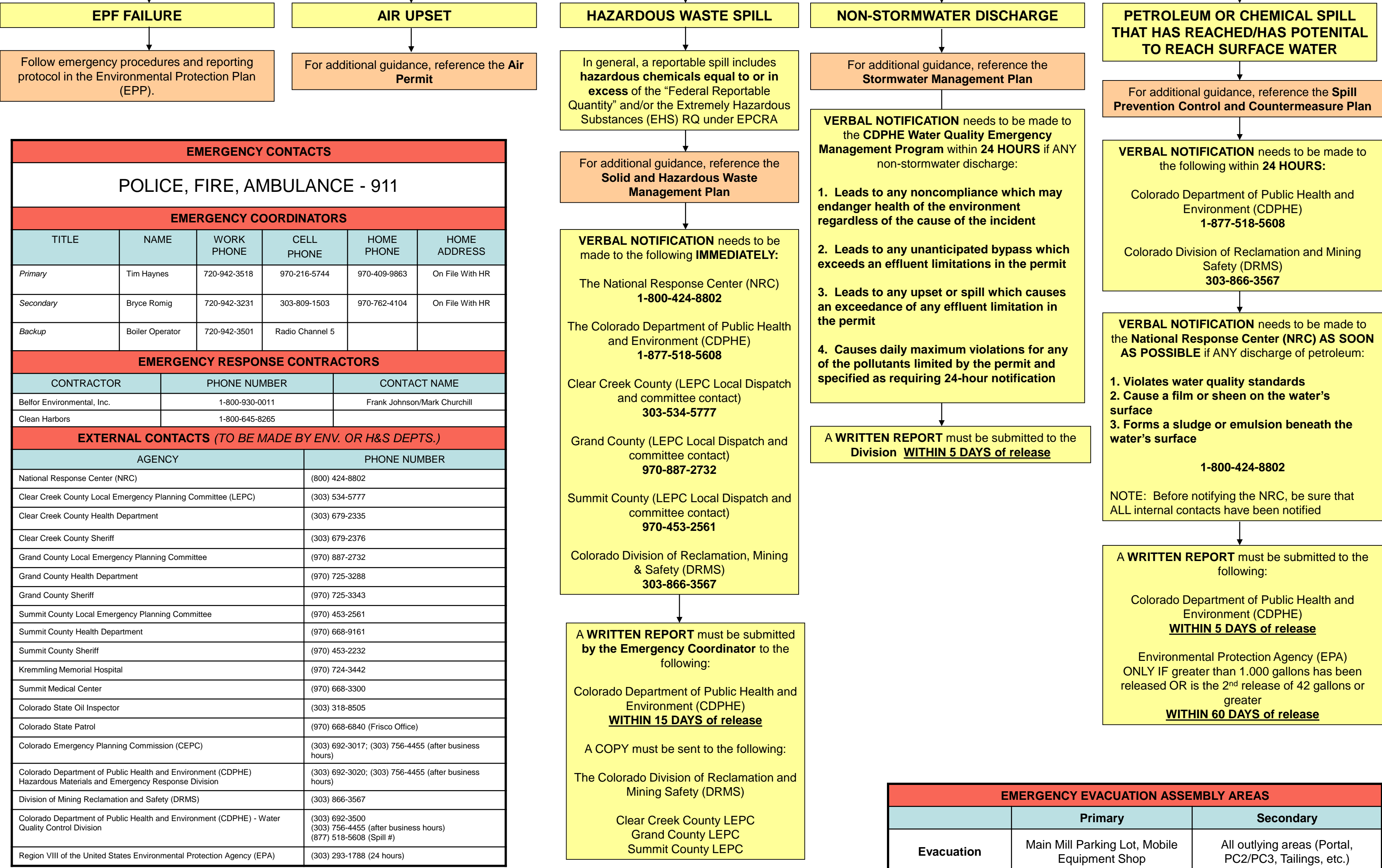
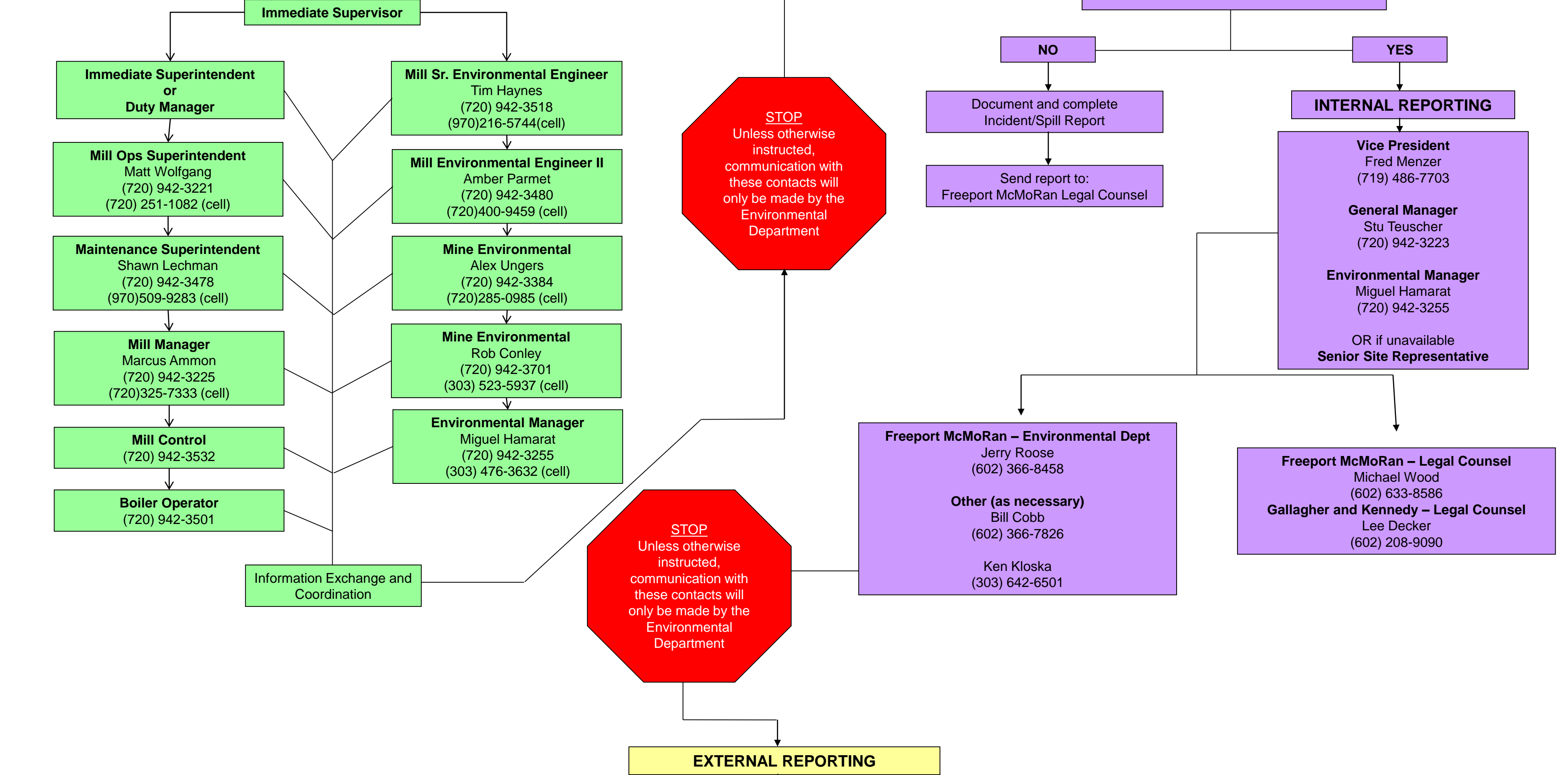
If able to do so safely, **CONTAIN THE RELEASE**

- Contain the spread of the released material with compatible absorbent material
  - Cover spill with enough absorbent material to contain all of the liquid.
  - Start from the outer edge of the spill and work towards the center.
- If necessary, construct earthen berms or pits to contain the released material.
- Precautions should be taken to prevent the release from reaching waterways (ponds, creeks, or water treatment systems).

If able to do so safely, **CLEAN UP THE RELEASE**

- Use appropriate method to clean up the applied absorbent
- Pick up any saturated booms.
- Place materials in a compatible/DOT approved container
