Dear Mr. Corson:

On November 30, 2015, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) filed your **Construction Material Limited Impact (110) Operation Reclamation Permit Application** for the Sheehan Pit, which is located in Moffat County. All comment and review periods began on November 30, 2015.

Please note that according to the board order the permit must be approved by December 21, 2015 which is earlier than the statutory requirements.

Within ten (10) days you must publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the locality of the proposed mining operation. **The final date for receiving comments is ten (10) days after the date of publication or the next regular business day.** Immediately after the publication, mail a copy of the notice to all owners of record of surface rights and mineral rights, holders of any recorded easements, and all owners of record of lands that are within 200 feet of the boundary of the affected land. Proof of notice and mailings, such as Certified Mail - Return Receipt Requested, must be submitted to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety prior to the decision date. Additionally, any changes or additions to the application on file in our office must also be reflected in the public review copy which has been placed with the Moffat County Clerk and Recorder.

The Division is reviewing your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Mined Land Reclamation Act. We will contact you if additional information is needed.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
