As per your discussion with Mickey Tine, principal of 42 Mining Company Ltd., operator of the Ruby Trust Mine in Ouray County, Colorado, this is to request approval for moving the 250 ton Ore Stockpile, as shown on the recent Ruby Trust Topographic Plat, to a location approximately 300 ft to the northwest of the present location and within the current permit boundary. This stockpile will remain covered with tarps in the new area until such time as a milling agreement is reached and the stockpile can be transported from the property for processing.

The present location of the stockpile is needed for muck that is being generated in the new adit/crosscut that is being driven to explore one of the veins recently intersected by core drilling. Thank you for your help with this since the immediate area is becoming muck-bound by the amount of material being generated in the crosscut. 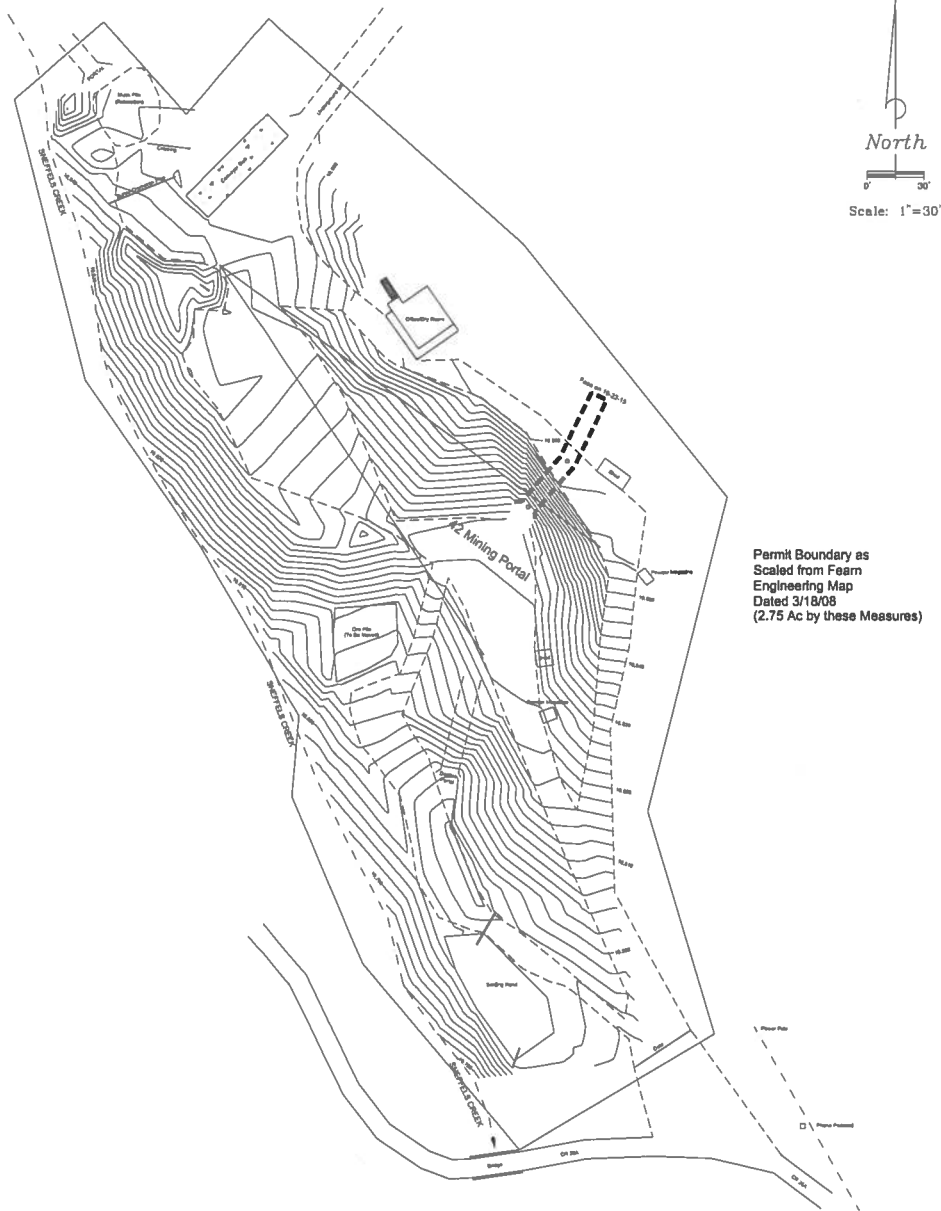
