Once your signed Agreement has been received and processed by the Division, you will be emailed a unique identifying account number, user name, and temporary password for use in sending and receiving information regarding annual reports and fees.

Once you have enrolled in the ePermitting System your account will remain active until all permits associated with your organization have been terminated. Permittees who have enrolled in the ePermitting System will receive electronic mail notices for upcoming due dates on future Annual Invoice and Report Requests instead of hard copy letters via post.
