Mr. Schnabel:

Upon the initial review of your 112 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Application for the Hitch Rack Ranch Quarry, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) has made the determination that the application will be classified as "complex". Therefore, the application decision date will be extended sixty (60) days beyond the usual maximum limit for an operation of this particular type and size as specified in Construction Materials Rule 1.4.1(7).

The Division called the application complete on March 08, 2016, with an initial decision date of June 06, 2016. <u>The new decision date for the application will be August 05, 2016, unless an extension of that deadline is requested by the operator.</u>

The Division is reviewing your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act. We will contact you if additional information is needed.
