What does ePermit involve? By opting in to ePermit, you consent that the Division may electronically send you any and all correspondence, notices, documents and information pertaining to your Minerals Permit(s) and/or NOI(s). You also agree that you will use ePermit to electronically send to the Division any and all correspondence, notices, documents and information. Such electronic correspondence, notices, documents and information. Such electronic correspondence, notices, documents and information represent electronic records, or "e-records" as that term is defined in C.R.S. § 24-71.3-102(7)\*.

**Email Address Required**. By opting in to ePermit, you agree that you will provide the Division with a viable email address by which you will receive e-records. You agree that, if you change your email address, it is your responsibility to provide the Division with a new email address promptly. You may provide the Division with your new email address by providing the information directly to the ePermit administrator for the Division (dnr\_drms\_permitadmin@state.co.us).
