OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety. The Richard Bachman Pit is located 5.5 miles southeast of Meeker, Colorado off of RBC Road No. 8. The site is a 112c operation. Clint Chappell representing Rio Blanco County accompanied the inspector during the inspection.

The mine identification sign and the affected area boundary markers are in place and in compliance with rule 3.1.12. The sign is located on a post at the main entrance of the gravel mine. The permit boundaries are comprised of fence posts that are easily identifiable around the entire perimeter of the mine.

The mine is active, however, due to the snow cover that existed no mining activities were observed during the inspection. Various stockpiles of material were observed on the pit floor. The majority of the permit area appeared to be disturbed.

The site was covered with approximately 1-2 inches of snow during the inspection therefore evaluation of revegetative success was not possible during the inspection. Topsoil stock piles were observed at the top and adjacent to the east slope of the permit area.

The operator stated that there was a plan to expand the permit acreage in the near future. The operator is aware that an amendment must be submitted and approved prior to increasing mining related disturbance outside of the currently approved permit area.

No evidence of erosion or off site damage was observed during the inspection.

Photos that show the conditions observed during the inspection are included at the end of this report.

No problems or violations were noted or observed during the March 16, 2016 inspection.
