Re: Pueblo Cement Plant and Limestone Quarry, DRMS File No. M-2002-004 Response to Groundwater Monitoring Evaluation

Dear Mr. Alvidrez:

On April 26, 2016, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your letter commenting on the groundwater monitoring evaluation and the proposed well. The Division is appreciative of the effort put forth in the preceding investigation and your letter. The proposed well location appears to be adequate. The Division would prefer that the well be either be a multilevel system containing a packer or seal to separate the Fort Hayes and the Codell Sandstone or a set of nested wells screening each interval. The Division would prefer quarterly sampling for the first year and a half. If no groundwater is encountered then sampling frequency could be reduced to biannual with one sampling event occurring during the summer and the other sampling event occurring during the winter.

In order to incorporate the new well described in the letter, the Operator will need to submit a Technical Revision (TR). At a minimum the TR shall demonstrate compliance with Rule 3.1.7 and contain the following:

- Monitoring well design
- Well completion and development
 - Topographic map, including the affected land boundary
 - Depict the fault and describe the fault displacement
 - Identify the dip and strike on both sides of the fault
 - Revised groundwater monitoring and sampling plans
 - Describe sampling method
 - o Identify sampling constituents and lab analytical method and analytical detection limits
 - o Propose reporting frequency and protocol
- Identify proposed numeric protection limits (NPL)
- Check for the \$216 TR fee
