Dear Mr. Anson:

The Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety (Division) inspected the above mentioned site on November 24, 2015. General compliance with mine plan was cited as problem. Corrective actions required that the operator submit in the form of a technical revision an updated and clarified mining and reclamation plan, as well as all correlating maps. The corrective action due date was set for March 10, 2016.

On May 27, 2016 the Division received an extension request from Mr. Anson. Mr. Anson is surveying the site and establishing control points to ensure better quality of maps moving forward. This newer technology has had some difficulties with the unseasonably wet spring and field work was delayed. Based on the continual effort put forth the Division is approving the extension request.

To avoid potential future enforcement actions for non-compliance with State Statutes, Rules and Regulations, and/or conditions specified in your permit for this site, you must submit compliance documentation with the corrective actions specified by **Friday, July 01, 2016.**
