Mr. Hodge:

The Loloff Mine has a problem noted that, according to Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) records has not yet been resolved. According to our records, the following problem was to be resolved on or before **April 15, 2016**. Listed below is a description and corrective action for the problem. **Please resolve the corrective action and provide evidence of such resolution on or before July 2, 2016.**

Please note if the corrective action is not properly addressed, and evidence provided to the Division by the date provided above, the listed problem could be escalated to the level of possible violation and would then be referred to the Mined Land Reclamation Board for further action.

PROBLEM/POSSIBLE VIOLATION: Problem #1: The dewatering activity at the Loloff Mine has caused disturbances to the prevailing hydrologic balance and is affecting the groundwater well located at 417 East 8th Street, Greeley, CO 80631 owned by Mr. Tyrrell.

CORRECTIVE ACTION #1: Loloff Construction, Inc. must implement the approved mitigation plan for the site and work with the affected well owner to investigate and rehabilitate the well.
