Dear Mr. Duran:

On June 6, 2016, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) considered your application filed for a 110 to 112 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Conversion application (CN-1) for the Martin Pit 1-A, which is located in Moffat. All comment and review periods began on June 6, 2016. The decision date for your application is scheduled for September 6, 2016.

Within ten (10) days you must publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the locality of the proposed mining operation. This notice must be published once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks. The final date for receiving comments is the 20th day after the fourth publication or the next regular business day. Immediately after the publication, mail a copy of the notice to all owners of record of surface rights and mineral rights, holders of any recorded easements, and all owners of record of lands that are within 200 feet of the boundary of the affected land. Proof of notice and mailings, such as Certified Mail - Return Receipt Requested, must be submitted to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety prior to the decision date. Additionally, any changes or additions to the application on file in our office must also be reflected in the public review copy which has been placed with the Moffat County Clerk and Recorder.

The Division is reviewing your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Mined Land Reclamation Act. We will contact you if additional information is needed.

Please be reminded that all operators must contact the Colorado Department of Health, Water Quality Control Division regarding storm water permits.
