OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. The operator was not present during the inspection. Photographs are included with this report that depict the site conditions observed during the inspection.

The Dotsero Cinder Pit is located approximately one mile northeast of Dotsero and accessed from Trail Gulch Road. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 9.3 permitted acres. The Division does not hold a financial warranty for the site.

The mine identification sign is in place and in compliance with rule 3.1.12. This was only a partial inspection and the upper portion of the mine was not inspected.

The site was inactive during the inspection. No stockpiles of of cinder material were observed around the stockpile area.

The stockpile area had evidence of use from off highway vehicles and no evidence of mining activity was observed.

No noxious weeds were observed. No erosional features or off-site damage was observed during the inspection.

No problems or possible violations were observed during the inspection.
