It should also show the permit boundary. I like the close-up view of the proposed storage area that you sent - so maybe you can submit the map we approved for AR-02 but somehow indicate on the map the proposed storage area (with arrow or circle). Then, you can add the permit #, etc. to the close-up view map you submitted, resubmit, and we can call it good. So, we're talking about submitting 2 maps: one that shows location of proposed storage area in relation to permit boundary, and the other is the close-up view.

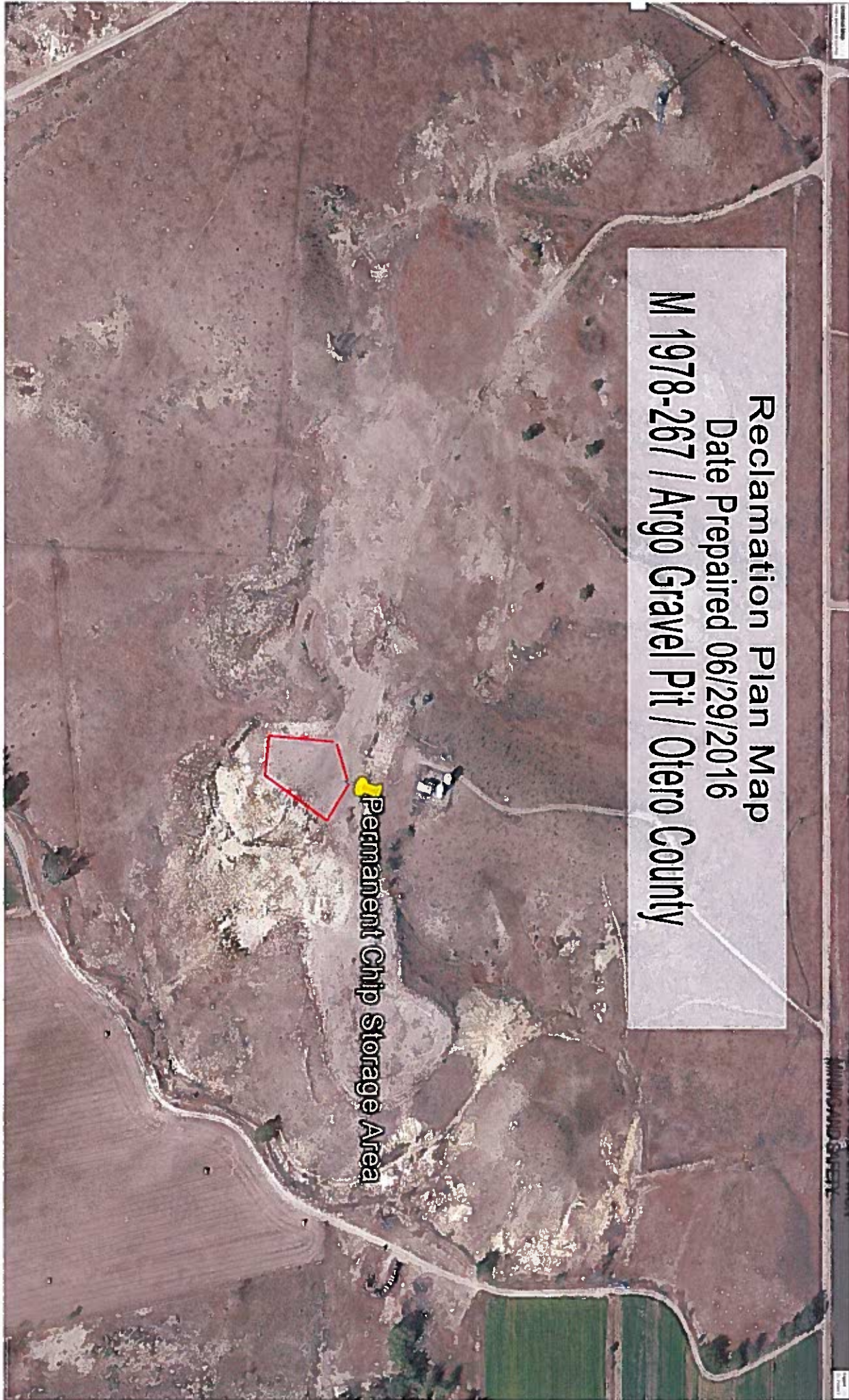
