On May 10, 2016 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) conducted an inspection of the above referenced site. Signs and Markers was cited as a problem in the inspection report for the absence of a mine sign. Corrective actions required that the operator post a sign at the mine entrance that meets Rule 3.1.12(1). The operator shall supply photo documentation that a sign was posted by the corrective action date.

On July 15, 2016 the Division received photo documentation via email that a new sign had been posted at the site. This satisfies the corrective action and it is considered abated.
