Bowie Resources, LLC, P.O. Box 1488, Paonia, CO 81428, has submitted a complete application for a technical revision (TR-61) to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety for its approved Bowie No. 1 Mine, mining permit No. C-1981-038. The technical revision will suspend the hydrologic monitoring of stations that are no longer considered necessary or do not provide useful information.

The Bowie No. 1 Mine is located in Delta County, approximately four (4) miles north of Paonia, CO. The Bowie No. 1 Mine loadout is located in Delta County approximately one mile east of Paonia, CO south of State Highway 133. All of the surface facilities are located north of the North Fork of the Gunnison River except a portion of the loadout located in Sections 29 and 32. Township 13 South, Range 91 West of the 6th P.M. The new mine and loadout permit areas are located on the U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute Bowie and Gray Reservoir, Colorado Quadrangle maps within of the following sections.
