The Bowie No. 2 Mine permit contains 10,987.2 acres of land, 5,723.9 acres of private surface and 5,263.3 acres of Federal surface. Private minerals within the permit area encompass 1,957 acres with Federal minerals accounting for the bai-ance of 9,030.2 acres.
