Re: Notice of <u>Rescheduled</u> Formal Board Hearing, Pre-hearing Conference and Recommendation Date; 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Application; Pueblo County Aggregate Project; DRMS File No. M-2016-009

Dear Party and/or Interested Person:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) appreciates you taking time to participate in the review process of the above referenced permit application. The application for the Pueblo County Aggregate Project (formerly known as the 44th Lane Project), File No. M-2016-009, was filed with the Division on February 26, 2016, by Fremont Paving & Redi-Mix Inc. (Applicant). On June 14, 2016, the Applicant filed an amendment to the application in review. The Applicant has requested an extension of the review period which has resulted in new dates for the Pre-hearing Conference and Formal Board Hearing, as clarified below.

Prior to the close of the public comment period, the Division received objections to the application. Therefore, pursuant to Rule 1.4.9(2)(a) and 1.7.4(2), the Division scheduled the application for a Mined Land Reclamation Board (Board) Hearing for consideration. The hearing was originally scheduled for June 22-23, 2016, which was continued to July 27-28, 2016, and again to the September 28-29, 2016, Board meetings; these hearings have been vacated. The issue has been rescheduled for the **October 26-27, 2016 Board meeting**. The Board Meeting will occur in <u>Colorado Springs</u>. During the hearing the Board will consider the application with objections and may decide to approve, approve with conditions, or deny the application. The date, time, and location of the October Board meeting in Colorado Springs will be provided under separate cover at a later time.

The September 13, 2016, Pre-hearing Conference has been vacated. Pursuant to Rule 2.7.1, the Division has rescheduled the Pre-hearing Conference to occur on **October 13, 2016**, in the Lucero Large Community Room at the Patrick A. Lucero Library at 1315 E 7th St, Pueblo, Colorado 81001, beginning at 1:30 p.m. and terminating at or before 3:30 p.m. Mr. James Stark will preside as the Pre-hearing Conference Officer. **As previously noticed, the Informal Public Meeting will still occur on September 13, 2016 from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at the Patrick A. Lucero Library. Please note, the notice listed the time as 10:30 p.m., which is in error; see enclosed Corrected Notice of Informal Public Meeting.**

The Pre-hearing Conference will be held to describe the Division's review process, to explain the rights and responsibilities of parties, to discuss and resolve issues to the extent possible, to describe the Board Hearing processes, to propose a list of issues under the Board's jurisdiction, to simplify that list, and to identify parties. All parties must supply at least thirty two (32) copies of lists of any exhibits and witnesses the parties intend to present at the Formal Board Hearing. List and exhibits must be exchanged between the parties at the Pre-hearing Conference in accordance with the requirements of Rule 2.6(2). Failure to participate in the Pre-hearing Conference will result in the loss of your party status.



After the conference, the Pre-hearing Officer shall prepare a proposed Pre-hearing Order. The proposed Pre-hearing Order will be made available to all parties prior to the Formal Board Hearing. The proposed Pre-hearing Order will contain a list of the parties, provide a recommended list of issues to be considered by the Board, and outline a schedule for the hearing with time allotments set for presentations by each party and the Office. The conditions of the Pre-hearing Order are not final until adopted or approved by the Board at the Formal Board Hearing. Any party has the right to file a motion to the Board to review any decision(s) of the Pre-hearing Officer according to the provisions of Rule 2.6(1).

All parties and interested persons who intend to participate in the Board hearing are strongly encouraged to attend the Pre-hearing Conference. Pursuant to Rule 2.7.3(4), any party who does not attend the Pre-hearing Conference forfeits its party status and all associated rights and privileges, unless such party provides a fully executed proxy authorization form to the Pre-hearing Conference Officer and the party's authorized representative is present. An official proxy authorization form is provided with the materials accompanying this letter. Additional copies of the official proxy authorization form may be obtained through the Division's web site at http://mining.state.co.us.

Pursuant to Rule 1.4.9, on or before **October 6, 2016**, the Division shall issue its recommendation to the Board for approval, approval with conditions, or denial of the application. A copy of the Division's recommendation will be forwarded to all parties and interested persons. For those parties who have received previous notice that the recommendation date was September 7, 2016, please note that this has been re-set by the Office for October 6, 2016.
